Nominator: Twin Rivers Curling Club

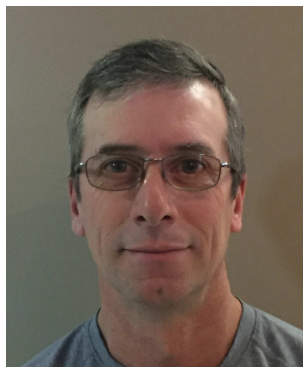
