The Laine Peters Award

Purpose: To provide tuition assistance to junior curlers to reimburse a portion of the tuition to attend the 2017 New Holland Prairieland Curling Camp. The monetary award will be given to two junior curlers who are chosen through an application process.

Amount of Funding: A donation of \$500, given as two monetary awards of \$250 each.

Number and Value of Awards: Two awards in the amount of \$250 each (one award for each camp) will be available to apply for in 2017.

Eligibility Restrictions:

1. The junior curler must register for and have full attendance at camp.
2. The applicant for the award must be a member in good standing at a Saskatchewan Curling Club.
3. The applicant must submit a complete application to be considered for the award. Please see the attached application.
4. The application must be postmarked by July 1, 2017 to be considered.

Selection Criteria: The selected award recipients will be chosen solely based on the application material provided by the applicant. The applicant is responsible for all costs associated with applying for the award.

Award Presentation: The Laine Peters Award will be presented to the annual chosen applicants at the closing presentation of camp by Ashley Howard, Executive Director of CURLSASK.

Award Conception: Laine Peters was born and raised in nearby Carrot River Saskatchewan. She has had an incredible curling career to date including 11 Scott Tournaments of Hearts appearances with 6 gold medal finishes, and 6 World Championship appearances to her credit. Laine continues to be a role model for how the game should be played through her competitive nature and unequalled sportsmanship, but equally as impressive is her love for and dedication to giving back within the sport of curling.
